COYOTE HOUSE DRIVER

POSITION SUMMARY: Provide transportation to Coyote House residents as needed. Residents at Coyote House want to get into the community more often to work, volunteer, and connect with others. We live about 5 miles away from a bus line making it difficult for residents to go into town as often they would like. Residents are looking for drivers to help with their transportation into town to increase their independence. You can help them get to their job or to the farmer's market or to the grocery store!

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Commit to at least two hours per month to be available for a Coyote House resident to contact you and ask for a ride.
- Drive Coyote House residents into town.
- Check weather reports/road conditions prior to picking up and driving individual.
- Obey all state laws and posted speed limits.
- Assist in loading and unloading of resident as needed.
- Maintain passenger safety.
- Report concerns, problems, and safety issues to staff in a timely fashion.
- Have a cell phone.
- Complete travel log of where you took the resident and how many miles.
- Ensures compliance with all Tierra Village policies.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Time Commitment: Be able to commit consistently to at least two shifts per month of at least one hour a shift. Shifts are available every weekday, except Mondays.
- Volunteers must be at least 21 years of age.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Must possess valid insurance.
- Pass a criminal background check.
